GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Applicant,

We are excited that you have chosen to continue your undergraduate education!

The following instructions are provided to assist you in the application process:

- 1.** Complete your application with the following information and please submit via **certified mail** to the address listed below
 - 1 A recent regular sized color photo of student.
 - 2 An official *sealed* copy of student's undergraduate college transcript from 1st semester of 1st year through 1st semester of current year (this includes fall 2007 grades).
 - 3 Proof of registration from student's undergraduate institution and current class schedule obtained from registrar's office. Online copies are not acceptable.
 - 4 One character reference from a college administrator/counselor or professor.
 - 5 WASFO Policy Statement signed by student.
 - 6 Completed Scholarship Application signed by student.
 - 7 Student's typed resume (one page) with all accomplishments, achievements, community/campus involvement, extra curricular and school activities in college only. Indicate all areas where you exercised leadership including any work experience.
 - 2 Student's typed double-spaced essay (two pages - Times New Roman 12-point font) on your favorite scripture from the Bible and how you use it to encourage you to pursue your academic and career goals. Be sure to include details of your long terms plans after graduating from college.
- 2.** Please answer all questions (typed or printed in black ink) on the application.
- 3.** Completed application materials **must be received via *certified mail* no later than Tuesday, March 4, 2008. Incomplete or late applications *will not be accepted*.**

WEST ANGELES SCHOLARSHIP FUND ORGANIZATION (WASFO)

The West Angeles Scholarship Fund Organization (WASFO) has been established to financially assist students who are **active** members of West Angeles Church of God in Christ. The following guidelines will be followed in administration of the fund.

1. The purpose of WASFO is to award scholarships to candidates who meet **ALL** eligibility requirements listed below. Funds are distributed based on contributions to meet our objectives.
2. Candidate eligibility requirements for continuing undergraduates are as follows:
 - 1 Candidate must have graduated from high school between May/June 2004 – May /June 2006.
 - 2 Candidate must currently be attending college at a 2 year or 4 year undergraduate institution. Students at a 2 year institution (Junior/Community College) must be in their 2nd year and those at a 4 year institution in their 2nd, 3rd or 4th year. 5th year seniors are not eligible. Transfer students who meet the graduation year requirements are eligible if they are in their 2nd, 3rd or 4th year of college only.
 - The candidate must have achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 and be in full-time status with at least 12 units.
 - The scholarship award must be used for costs incurred in attending the current college.
 - The candidate must be an active member for a minimum of 1 year and in good standing (**validated by a membership number**) and supporter of West Angeles Church of God in Christ.
 - Employees of West Angeles Church of God in Christ are not eligible for scholarship awards.
 - Candidate must assist with at least two WASFO activities. Activities will be determined by WASFO Committee. Activities may consist of assisting Youth Department/Higher Learning Ministries or Collegiate & Young Adults Ministries, announcements during scholarship month, etc. For those candidates attending college out of the local area special activities will be arranged in order to complete activity requirement.
****ALL applicants are responsible for contacting Jasmine C. Houston (westa_scholarships@yahoo.com) to make sure this requirement has been fulfilled.**
3. Scholarship monies will be awarded in one check AFTER PROOF OF ENROLLMENT AND A CLASS SCHEDULE is submitted to WASFO. **Students should not depend on scholarship funds for initial registration/tuition fees.**
4. All eligible candidates may apply by completing an application. All application materials must be submitted in one complete packet. **INCOMPLETE PACKETS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.**
5. **APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE DATE WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.**
6. All scholarships will be awarded by WASFO.
7. Candidates awarded scholarships will be notified by an official letter from WASFO.
8. Unclaimed funds remaining at the close of each fiscal year will be returned to the general scholarship fund and cannot be redeemed after June 2, 2008.
